Transport Engineers at Monash (TEM) is a student chapter of the Institute of Transport Engineers Australia and New Zealand. We aim to bridge the gap between students and the industry.

Our Mentoring Program

We are currently looking for mentors for our mentoring program and we would like you to be a part of it!

In the mentoring program, we pair one student with one professional from the transport industry. The students are all from Monash University. Many students apply and a few are selected based on their responses to the application and the availability of professionals. In the 2018 batch there are 50 mentees and 50 mentors.

The program lasts for one year, at the end of which they are provided with a certificate. All mentors also receive a formal letter of appreciation upon completion of the program.

After we pair the mentors and mentees, each pair is free to choose their own venue, frequency of meetings and method of interaction. TEM catches up with the participants of the program every three months to obtain feedback and resolve any issues the participants might be facing.
